How Did the Fund Perform Last Year?

Ultra SmallCap600 (the "Fund") seeks daily investment results, before fees and expenses, that correspond to two times (2x) the daily performance of the S&P SmallCap 600 Index (the "Index"). The Fund invests in financial instruments that the Advisor believes, in combination, should produce daily returns consistent with the Fund's investment objective. For the year ended May 31, 2025, the Fund had a total return of -14.88% and an average daily statistical correlation of over 0.99 to twice that of the return of the Index. For the same period, the Index had a total return of -1.75% and a volatility of 24.32%. The Index performance was driven by small caps which delivered modest returns amid macroeconomic uncertainty during the period, lagging their larger cap counterparts. Primary factors affecting Fund performance include the total return of the securities and derivatives held by the Fund, the performance of the reference assets to which any derivatives are linked, financing rates paid or earned, expenses, transaction costs, the volatility of the Fund's Index (and its impact on compounding), and other miscellaneous factors.
